THE RULES OF THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM AT ST. CONSTANCE SCHOOL, YEAR 2020/2021

GUIDELINES OF STATE OF ILLINOIS AND ARCHDIOCESE OF CHICAGO

According to the Archdiocese of Chicago's ordinance, religious lessons can be taught by catechists only once a month. Therefore, in order to maintain the continuity of our students' education and bearing in mind the important role that religion plays in the formation and approximation of children and young people to the Church, the Religious Program introduces the following regulations for the school year 2020/2021:

1. Religion education will be mostly every first Sunday of the month from 10:30am to 2:00pm
2. Every class will start in the Church with Sunday Mass. After the Mass children will go to the Borowczyk Hall. From there they will follow catechists to their classrooms.
3. Religion lessons will combine devotions, projects, movie projections and other activities. This will make the lessons interesting and develop students' creativity.
4. There will be 15 students and a Catechist in each classroom.
5. We will start our program on October 4th at 10:30am in the Church

SCHEDULE - FIRST SUNDAY OF THE MONTH:

10:30am	-	Sunday Mass with Family members (children will sit with their classmates and teachers – first pews)
11:30am	-	students will go to the Borowczyk Hall
11:45am	-	classes will start
1:40pm	-	pick up - Grades 0 through 2
1:50pm	-	pick up - Grades 3 through 5
2:00pm	-	pick up - Grades 6 through 8

- **Please pick up students at the allotted time to keep the social distance.**
- **Children who are not picked up on time will be carried into Borowczyk Hall.**
- **Parents of children who will be picked up children from Borowczyk Hall will pay the "late fee" of \$20**

- **A non-refundable deposit of \$100 should be made on the day of your child's registration.**
- **The school year fee must be paid by November.**
- **Financial assistance is available in our Parish**
