GUIDELINES OF STATE OF ILLINOIS AND ARCHDIOCESE OF CHICAGO

- 1. Children and adults entering school must wear a mask.
- 2. Both teachers and students must wear a mask during the class period.
- 3. Every person entering the class must disinfect his or her hands.
- 4. Students do not change classes.
- 5. The use of hallways and bathrooms will be based on guidelines for the preservation of social distance.
- 6. Teachers will disinfect desks in classrooms and students' hands during the lesson. The whole school will be deep disinfected/cleaned every evening.
- 7. Parents/Guardians will only be allowed into the school in exceptional and necessary situations.
- 8. A student who has any symptoms of the disease before school must stay at home.
- 9. If a student or family member has been diagnosed with COVID 19, the parent must immediately notify the school so that the entire class and teacher are quarantined for 14 days.

SCHEDULE – EVERY MONDAY – 6:00PM – 7:30 PM

- Religion education will be mostly every week on Monday from 6:00pm to 7:30pm.
- Students enter through the breezeway door from the parking lot side. They will also exit through the same door.
- We will start our program on September 13th at 6:00pm.
- ➤ Please pick up students at 7:30pm from the parking lot side entrance.
- Please keep the social distance when picking up your child.
- > Children who are not picked up on time will be taken to Borowczyk Hall.
- > Parents of children who will be picked up children from Borowczyk Hall will pay the "late fee" of \$20
 - ➤ A non-refundable deposit of \$100 should be made on the day of your child's registration.
 - > The school year fee must be paid by October.
