How to practice centering prayer

- Choose a word. This word, called a sacred word, should represent your intention to consent to God's presence and action within you. ...
- Introduce the word. Sit comfortably and with your eyes closed. ...
- Settle deeply into prayer. ...
- Gently conclude the time of prayer.

The essence of centering prayer is **consent to the presence and activity of God in one's life**. In response to our intention to become more deeply united with the divine presence, God acts within us to transform us, making us more like Christ. One's intimacy with God deepens and one's awareness of that intimacy expands. Aug 3, 2020
