

CONFIRMATION SERVICE PROJECTS

The St. Constance School and REP Confirmation candidates will participate in projects of service to the people of St. Constance Parish and those in our and other communities. Each candidate will complete a minimum **15 hours of service plus at least one parish project and one project with his/her sponsor. Service projects are due March 4th, 2022.**

Some suggestions for service projects include:

Join the choir
Visit the elderly at home or in a nursing home
Baby-sit for someone who needs help (not siblings)
Initiate a “clean-up” campaign in the parish or school
Collect, clean, repair clothing for the poor
Prepare a meal for a family who is in need
Work in a special education program
Make gifts or favors for hospitals or nursing homes
Prepare entertainment or holiday parties for nursing homes or child care center
Help in the school library
Help a needy family
Help with parish mailings
Assist senior citizens with their chores

Volunteer work in a hospital
Tutor after school
Shop for an elderly neighbor or relative
Work at a food bank
Perform social services for the handicapped
Collect toy for poor children
Read the blind
Assist with young children’s sports activities
Assist with Anointing Mass and/or Grieving Mass
Advent Giving Tree
Help to clean the church
Be a lector or usher at weekend liturgy
